Introduction of the bus tutors

Dear parents, dear classmates,

Approximately 500 pupils use the Gaesdonck school buses every day. To ensure that all users can travel as smoothly and safely as possible, we would like to point out important behavioural guidelines at the start of the new school year. We would like to ask you to discuss these with your children, especially with our new classmates of the Sexta (Year 5). Experience has shown that it is particularly important to make the best possible use of the space on the bus. Furthermore, masks must be worn on the bus until further notice.

The school regulations state, among other things:

- Every pupil has the right to an undisturbed bus ride, therefore all pupils should behave considerately.
- The seat or standing area may not be left during the journey.



- Standing areas and aisles must not be blocked with school bags and backpacks.
- Rubbish should be avoided or disposed of in existing containers.
- The instructions of the bus drivers and bus tutors must be followed.

The bus journey will also be more pleasant and safer for everyone if

- School bags and backpacks are placed between the legs for space reasons and not left on the back.
- for safety reasons, the seats are used first, then the standing areas,
- to the front or back and do not stop in the entrance area,
- Seats are available to all and are not kept free,
- everyone to behave in a considerate manner so please do not get angry, listen to loud music, put your feet up on seats, etc.

To ensure that this succeeds, we bus tutors are on duty for your children on our bus routes. We support the bus driver and actively help by talking to fellow pupils and giving advice on correct behaviour.

In case of problems, it is best for the students to contact us first, so that we have the opportunity to solve them together with the students themselves. All students are obliged to inform us of their name and class or level if necessary.

We ask all parents and students to support us in carrying out this task.
