## **Childcare situation on the Fridays before the homecoming weekend**

After the long Corona break, we are very pleased about the high demand for the services of the day boarding school - not least on the previous Fridays before the home weekends. Since the beginning of the school year, Mrs Wischerhoff is coordinating the care of all day boarding pupils who would like to be on site until 4.30 p.m. on the Fridays before the home weekends, in order to better coordinate the care and study offers on these Fridays.

In order for Mrs. Wischerhoff to be able to guarantee reliable supervision and personal care for your child, we would like to ask you to register your child for Friday care before the home weekends by e-mail with Mrs. Wischerhoff ([wischerhoff@gaesdonck.de](mailto:wischerhoff@gaesdonck.de)). Of course, you are free to make a different decision at any time. In these cases, however, Mrs. Wischerhoff would also like to receive a short notification.

## **Info about arrival on Sunday**

Arrival for our full boarding students next Sunday, 12.09.2021 will take place as usual between **18.00 and 20.00 hrs.** Arrival will continue to be via the main car park only. **All students** please register at our test centre in the music school before entering the campus.

As already communicated in the last letters to parents, arrival is still subject to the presentation of a current **Covid 19 test** (24 hours before arrival at the latest) - even for students who have already been fully vaccinated or have recovered. Of course, the test can still be carried out directly at the music school. However, due to regular testing during the school days, a 15-minute wait for the test result is currently not necessary. It is also **not necessary** to fill out the arrival form at the moment.
