A little out of the ordinary, we are contacting you today with some practical advice for the next few days, especially regarding school bus transport. Bus timetable - timetable adjustment of line 13

Obviously increased traffic volume has caused line 13 (Huisberden→ Goch) to arrive late at Gaesdonck bus station several times since the winter holidays.

After consultation with the bus company, we will remedy this with slightly earlier bus route departure times. This **change will be effective from Monday 23.01.2023.** The changed timetables are as follows:


Postcard for pupils:

Appendix: Computer typing course

Based on the results of brain research and pedagogy, this computer typing course uses visualisation and association techniques, insights from NLP, multi-sensory approaches and networked thinking. The course goal is only achieved through regular practice. On the last day of the course, a 10-minute writing session is held as a final test. Participants will receive a certificate upon completion of the course.

Participation

The minimum number of participants is 10, the maximum is 15 students.

The course fee depends on the number of participants. As soon as we have a fixed number of registrations, we will announce the course fee.
