We kindly ask you to discuss with your child whether participation in confirmation preparation at Gaesdonck is an option. The aim of the preparation is to create time and space to explore one's own faith and important questions in life. At the end, the personal decision for or against confirmation is made.

Regardless of whether your child is already certain that they want to be confirmed, is still searching for answers in their faith, or is simply interested in discussing questions such as "Who is God?" or "Why believe?" with other young people, confirmation preparation offers suitable activities and support for all of these.

On **Sunday, 16 November 2025, at 5 p.m.**, we cordially invite you to the traditional St. Martin's Procession at Gaesdonck. The meeting point is the Marble Square. There we will bless the lanterns made in class and then start the procession together.

The Uedem Youth Orchestra will provide musical accompaniment. We would be delighted if adults would accompany the procession with the torches provided – this will enhance the special atmosphere of the evening. After returning to the schoolyard, we will be treated to a modern staging of the St. Martin's play, which invites reflection and wonder.

The Scouts will bathe the Primanerhof in atmospheric lighting and offer (hot) drinks. Our kitchen will also take care of your physical well-being.
